The Florida Clean Marina Program is a voluntary designation program with a proactive approach to environmental stewardship. To become designated as a Florida Clean Marina, facilities must implement a set of environmental Best Management Practices (BMPs) designed to protect Florida's waterways. These BMPs address critical issues such as sensitive habitat, waste management, storm water control, spill prevention, and emergency preparedness.

Speaking at a recent awards ceremony held at The Tarpon Club Marina, General Manager Robert Fesik stated that "we always strive to be a good steward of the environment. This designation recognizes our entire staff's proactive approach and ongoing dedication to best management practices in maintaining our unique community and natural resources."

Jon Iglehart, Director of District Management for the DEP, stated that The Tarpon Club Marina is "bringing jobs and business to the area in a responsible way." He added that the Florida Clean Marina designation is a prime example of how business can take the lead in doing what is right.

Centrally located in the Isles of Capri, the Tarpon Club Marina provides direct boating access to the Gulf of Mexico and scenic backwaters. The marina offers fully covered and enclosed dry storage, providing boaters
